MEDLIFE is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that partners with low-income communities in Latin America and Africa to improve their access to medicine, education, and community development. The organization achieves its impact by running mobile clinics, a comprehensive patient follow-up

care program, educational workshops, and infrastructure projects to propel community development. For fifteen years, MEDLIFE has worked with students at 220 academic institutions, providing them with volunteering and leadership opportunities. Now, as they scale their programs in infrastructure, including retention walls, staircases, and public parks, they are looking for student leaders that study engineering or architecture to join the MEDLIFE movement.

To accomplish this, they're running a spring and summer internship program, wherein students will travel to our HQ in Lima for 2 weeks, and then work with us to build an Engineering Community on their campus.
