To assist this crucial need, we want you to spend around 20 minutes from a laptop or tablet to take the 2022 UCUES and help us tackle campus-wide food insecurity.

For each UCUES submitted between May 2–May 12, UC Davis Budget and Institutional Analysis will contribute \$1.00 to the Pantry. With your support, we can grow our programs to keep students safe and food-secure. During the Pantry campaign, you will remain eligible for other UCUES gift card drawings. ## REMINDER-DFI EDUCATIONAL TRUST MICHAEL CONDON SCHOLARSHIP-APPLICATION DEADLINE MAY 16

The DFI Educational Trust, the charitable arm of the Deep Foundations Institute (DFI), is pleased to request applications for the 2022 Michael Condon Civil Engineering Scholarship.

Eligibility is limited to students attending the following institutions only: California Polytechnic State University- San Luis Obispo; California Polytechnic State University-Pomona; San Diego State University; Santa Clara University; University of California-Davis; Oregon State University; Washington State University; Montana Tech; University of Colorado-Boulder; Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University (Virginia Tech).

Applicants must be full-time students pursuing a graduate or undergraduate degree in civil engineering; have a minimum GPA of 3.0; demonstrate an interest in the deep foundations industry; and demonstrate financial need.
