## PEER Student Committee Future of Research Series Seminar 2

The <u>PEER student committee</u> is hosting its second Research series. This seminar will focus on learnings from the recent earthquake that struck Türkiye and Syria on February 6, 2023. The seismic sequence caused widespread damage and destruction; sadly, more than 46,000 people have died. The seminar will be led by Dr. Robb Moss, Professor at California Polytechnic State University San Luis Obispo, who leads the GEER advanced reconnaissance team to assess on-site conditions in Türkiye and help organize subsequent teams to target specific hazards. Dr. Moss will present a broad overview of the events and the lessons that the earthquake has taught our earthquake engineering community.
